session format 1: panel discussions	recommended panel size of between 2 and 5 speakers to make some brief remarks or conduct a debate followed by a Question & Answer (Q&A) session. A single panel rather than multiple panels in the time provided is encouraged. The Q&A can use questions collected from the in-person audience or through the chat/Q&A feature in the online event platform. A polling feature could also be used to engage with the audience, subject to availability in the online event platform. The moderator will summarize the key points from the discussion at the end.
Full-length session format 2: non-panel discussions (please specify details)	This format consists of any non-panel open discussion format where in 60 minutes the audience participation takes up more than two-thirds of the time and this participation is encouraged by sub-dividing the audience or arranging them into smaller groups such as in a beehive or fishbowl format or holding bilateral conversations. Please provide exact details of the proposed format in this answer.
Shortened session: Ignite/lightning talks or other (please specify details)	This format consists of a SINGLE speaker giving a short talk for up to 20 minutes on a key idea or topic. Up to 3 talks will feature in a full-length session slot on the programme. There will be no extra time given to take questions from the audience, but speakers can respond to questions posted on the chat/Q&A feature in the online event platform either before or after the talk.
Special format 1: announcement or launch	This format will be conducted in a dedicated area of the Forum venue for announcements or press style launch, such as an exhibit or media space, and can include book readings by authors, short presentations on newly released reports and static demonstrations of knowledge sharing platforms.
Special format 2: interactive learning activity	This format will be conducted in a dedicated area of the Forum venue, such as an exhibit or media space, for audience participation in workshops, data labs or competitions to promote new skills or offer collaboration on a new data initiative. These activities will be facilitated by organizers based on a set of presentations and/or training modules and hands-on exercises and participants would bring their own devices as appropriate to fully participate. The format can include participants voting on preferred solutions or use of a panel of judges. This format may require the provision of some funds from a specific entity.
Special format 3: demonstration or interactive exhibit	This format will be conducted in a dedicated area of the Forum venue, such as an exhibit or media space, to demonstrate data visualization or show other audiovisual displays such as a short film or documentary on data use and innovation to transforms lives. These displays should be a creative combination of art, data science and storytelling while also functional and able to communicate important data or information clearly and effectively to the audience. They can be an outcome of a documentary competition organized and concluded prior to the Forum.
